## A reminder of our return to school plans.

### 1. Uniform

Children should return to school in uniform, **including ties and black shoes**. There is no evidence that ties can contribute to the spread of the virus, so children should return to school in full uniform. Please ensure children bring their correct PE kit.

### 2. The beginning and end of the school day

Arrival and leaving times are listed below. We would ask that children arrive punctually at these times, as we are very keen not to lose any more learning time. Parents and carers should practise social distancing on the playground at all times, using the yellow spots marked out. We ask that face masks are worn by adults on the playground, and that the site is vacated as quickly as possible, both in the morning and the afternoon.

As we will be working hard to keep bubbles separate throughout the day, we would urge you to ensure children do not mix with children from other bubbles on the playground at the beginning and end of the day.

### 3. Books

Some children have borrowed books to read at home. Please return these on 8<sup>th</sup> March.

### 4. Mitigation measures

We are putting in place several measures to keep children in safe. These include, encouraging social distancing, children in class all facing the front, extra cleaners employed during the day, frequent handwashing, face masks for adults in public areas, good ventilation in classrooms, asymptomatic testing of staff and PPE worn by staff administering first aid.

### 5. School Meals

We will return to a full school meal service, with children eating in the hall and choosing their own meal, eliminating the need for pre ordering.

### 6. Year 5 and 6 only

In order to keep bubbles separate at playtimes, Year 5 and 6 will have a long morning. They may therefore bring a **healthy** snack for playtime, such as a piece of fruit. This must not include sweets, chocolate or crisps.

### 7. Breakfast club

Breakfast club will resume from Tuesday 9th March, initially for the children of critical workers only. Places will need to be pre-booked using this form <https://forms.gle/LAWbYv7pPrQD11a87>

Please try to walk, cycle or scoot to school where possible. If you do drive, please stay in you car until it's time for children to enter the building, and please don't be offended if we hurry you off the playground or remind you about mask wearing!
